



2025 CODE OF CONDUCT

105.1 CONDUCT: All individuals shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Physical violence or abuse of any individual, official, participant, or spectator at the site of an NKC/WKA sanctioned event will subject the offender to immediate disqualification, ejection from the event site, and possible suspension of membership status and arrest.

105.2 VERBAL ABUSE: Verbal abuse or threats directed at any individual, official, participant, or spectator by anyone at the site of an NKC/WKA sanctioned event will subject the offender to immediate disqualification, ejection from the event site and possible suspension of membership status. Verbal abuse of any adult towards any minor will result in an automatic one event suspension.

105.3 PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES: All participants entering the restricted area (pits) of an NKC/WKA sanctioned event shall be sober and not under the influence of any substance that may impair their ability to participate in a safe and orderly manner. It is the responsibility of the participant to withdraw from competition if they are taking medication that may display side effects that would impair their ability to safely compete. If, in the judgment of the officials in charge, an individual is under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance during an NKC/WKA sanctioned event, he or she may be ejected from the restricted area and/or NKC/WKA sanctioned event site immediately.

105.4 PIT CREWS: Drivers are responsible for the control and actions of their pit crew and family members. Unacceptable actions of crew and family members may subject the driver to penalties or disqualification from an NKC/WKA sanctioned event and possible suspension of member privileges.

105.5 RESTRICTED AREA: All individuals entering the restricted area of an NKC/WKA sanctioned event must sign and execute all insurance related documents as prescribed for that NKC/WKA sanctioned event. Failure to do so will subject the individual to disqualification, immediate removal from the restricted area and/or suspension of membership privileges.

ARTICLE III, Section 11: Knives exceeding state regulations, weapons deemed illegal by the state of CT, and all firearms are prohibited from all club events. First offense will minimally be a 1 race/event expulsion. Second offense or threatening with a weapon on first offense will result in a lifetime expulsion from the club.
